PREFACE

The **Conference on Partial Differential Equations and Applications, Sofia, September 14–16, 2011 (In honor of 65-th Anniversary of Professor Petar Popivanov)** took place in the premises of the Institute of Mathematics and Informatics (IMI) of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (BAS). The conference was organized by the Section “Differential Equations and Mathematical Physics” of IMI with the participation of research groups on PDE from Università di Cagliari and Università di Torino (Italy), with the organizing committee – N. Kutev (IMI–BAS) – chair, G. Boyadzhiev (IMI–BAS) – secretary, T. Gramchev (Univ. Cagliari) and A. Oliaro (Univ. Torino) – members, and the following program/scientific committee: T. Gramchev (chair), N. Kutev (IMI–BAS), L. Rodino (Università di Torino), M. Ruzhansky (Imperial College London), A. Slavova (IMI–BAS), C. Van Der Mee (Università di Cagliari).

There were 30 talks given by participants from academic centers from 5 countries (Bulgaria – 7, Italy – 7, Germany – 1, Ireland – 1, UK – 1), 7 invited lectures of 45 min, 7 invited regular talks of 30 min and 6 short communications of 20 minutes. There was an informal open problem session and the possibilities for informal seminars and discussions with many participants. Most of the talks are published in the present volume. Each paper was accepted for publication after an international refereeing process. The volume starts with short notes dedicated to the jubilee of Prof. Petar R. Popivanov. The editor would like to thank to all referees.
